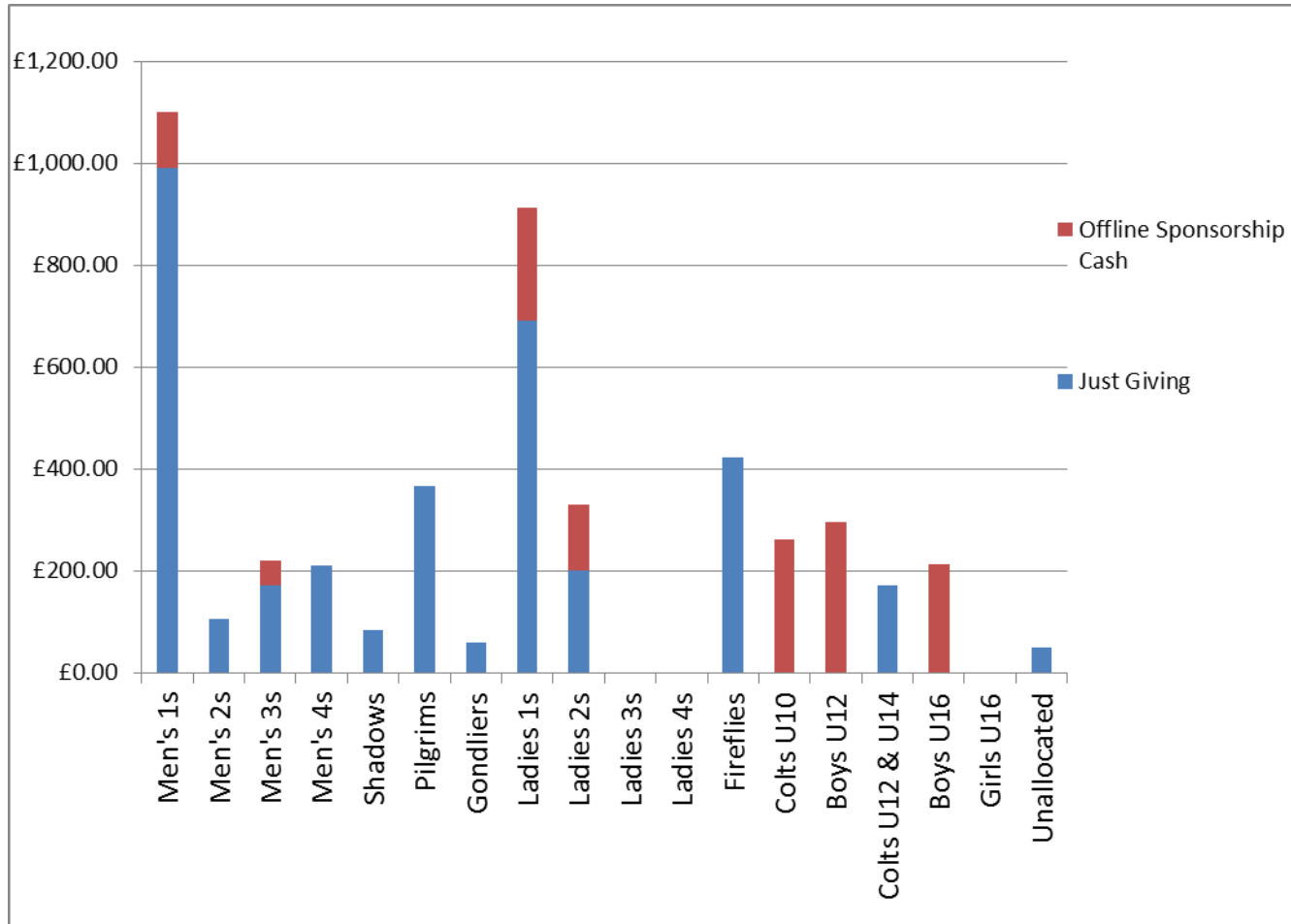

How the day will work:

Raise at least £20 and take part in the Hockeython for free. You will still need to pay entry to the end of season party in the evening.

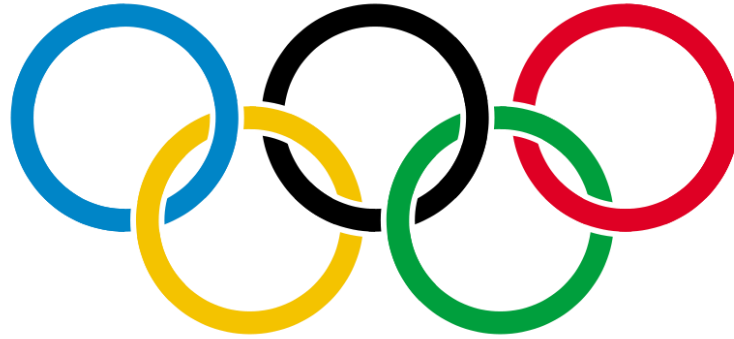
If you raise at least £100, you will be able to take part in the Hockeython and gain entry to the end of season party for free!
